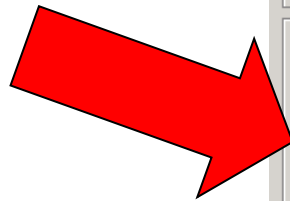

ANESTHESIA: Alcaine, 2% Lidocaine with Epinephrine
COMPLICATIONS: None. The patient tolerated the procedure well.

INDICATIONS: The patient presented in the office complaining of changes in vision and a decrease in visual acuity. An anterior segment examination revealed conjunctival injection, conjunctival vascularization, CME, DME, Retinal vein occlusion, and a condition that is likely to progress rapidly if not treated.

DESCRIPTION OF PROCEDURE: The patient was prepped and draped in the sterile position and a copy provided to the patient. A drop of 2% Lidocaine with Epinephrine was placed in inferior conjunctiva was prepped with a 5% povidone-iodine solution. The conjunctiva was then anesthetized with 2% Lidocaine with Epinephrine. An injection of 0.05cc of AVASTIN 1.25 mg was then given at marked area. The patient's IOP is checked using a Goldmann tonometer and appropriate measures are taken to lower IOP to improve disc perfusion. Erythromycin ointment was applied to the operative eye.
